

## Churchill Park Rainbow Curriculum

### A Developmental Curriculum:- that

leads on from the Early Years Foundation Stage and allows teachers and assistants to use a topic based approach to involve all in engaging and stimulating experiences to access the curriculum and achieve. Some pupils are accessed in a more structured way to address their individual needs, whilst others have a more sensory approach. All pupils work in mixed ability classes.

KS4 Pupils in this key stage work at their own level in the core subjects [English, Mathematics, Science] PSHE, PE & RE. There is an entitlement to study an 'option' in each of the below areas.

- The Arts [art & design, music, dance, drama, & media arts]
- Design & technology,
- Humanities [History & Geography]
- MFL [not compulsory after 14] Some recognised accreditation will be offered

### 6<sup>th</sup> Form

Students are encouraged to create their own learning pathway based upon what they would like to do when they leave school. We are able to offer a dual placement with some students having access to our Providence Street site, where they can access independent living skills, and their local community.
